# BUSINESS IN FREDERICK MARYLAND

With our Director Richard Griffin traveling internationally this month, I'm honored to step in and share a few updates featured in our July Economic Development eNewsletter:

The interim report for [ACCESS GRANTED](#) is in! We're excited to spotlight several small businesses that received funding through the City's ACCESS GRANTED program. While final reporting isn't due until year's end, the early success stories are already inspiring — stay tuned as more roll in!

In July, we joined the City in celebrating a major community initiative: the opening of the [City of Frederick's state-of-the-art Police Headquarters](#). This long-anticipated project brings the FPD team together under one roof for the first time — a true game changer for public safety in our city. In addition, Governor Wes Moore and the Board of Public Works today approved a [\\$7.5 million capital grant](#) to support the Downtown Frederick Hotel and Conference Center project, a highly anticipated development that will transform local capacity and positioning in the region.

This month, we also leaned into workforce development with two impactful events. First, we convened a panel of biotech HR leaders to discuss growing biotech talent in Frederick, an especially timely conversation as residents and contractors navigate recent federal workforce shifts. We also welcomed [Frederick County Public School Career Coaches](#) for a behind-the-scenes look at economic development and employer tours with [AstraZeneca](#), [Frederick Health](#), and [Stulz USA](#). It was a great way to build bridges between our schools and major local employers.

In other news, we welcomed new businesses, [Penny Mart](#), [Vault of Visions Art Gallery](#), [PEAK Acupuncture and Wellness](#) and [Serenity Swimming \(SHE Pitch winner\)](#) and celebrated other milestones, including the completion of the “rejuvenation” project for [Precision for Medicine](#)'s office and biorepository at Riverside Research Park and [Engage USA's 25th Anniversary](#) — congratulations to all!

And while we're halfway through summer, we wanted to make you aware that [stormwater upgrades along East Street](#) continue to progress. The street remains closed, with reopening expected in late August. In the meantime, please join us in supporting the fantastic small businesses along this corridor — we know they will truly appreciate your support!

### Interim Report: Small Business Impact from ACCESS GRANTED

Last year, the City of Frederick awarded \$400,000 in competitive grants to 55 small businesses through its **ACCESS GRANTED** program. Recipients represented a broad mix of industries and



neighborhoods across the city—including health and wellness providers, personal care services, retail shops, food and beverage ventures, tech startups, fitness studios, and creative enterprises.
