
# BUSINESS IN FREDERICK MARYLAND

Greetings!

This week I joined Governor Wes Moore and other state officials as he named national cyber czar [Harry Coker, Jr. as Maryland's new Secretary of Commerce](#) to lead the push for increased private investment, jobs, and tax base. Just last month Governor Moore and his cabinet attended the Downtown Frederick Hotel and Conference Center groundbreaking ceremony to demolish the old FNP Press Room – making way for the new \$103 million economic development project. At that event Governor Moore has issued a far reaching [Executive Order](#) to bolster competitiveness and subsequently has proposed the transformational legislation package known as the Decade Act of 2025 to lower the corporate tax rate, streamline permitting, and align resources and incentives. The Maryland Economic Development Association (MEDA) is tracking legislation which can be viewed at on the [MEDA website](#). We wish former Secretary of Commerce Kevin Anderson well as he ascends to a senior economic advisor to Governor Moore.

Frederick continues to lead the state in new investment, jobs, and residential growth. 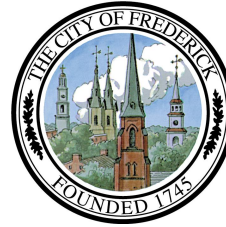
